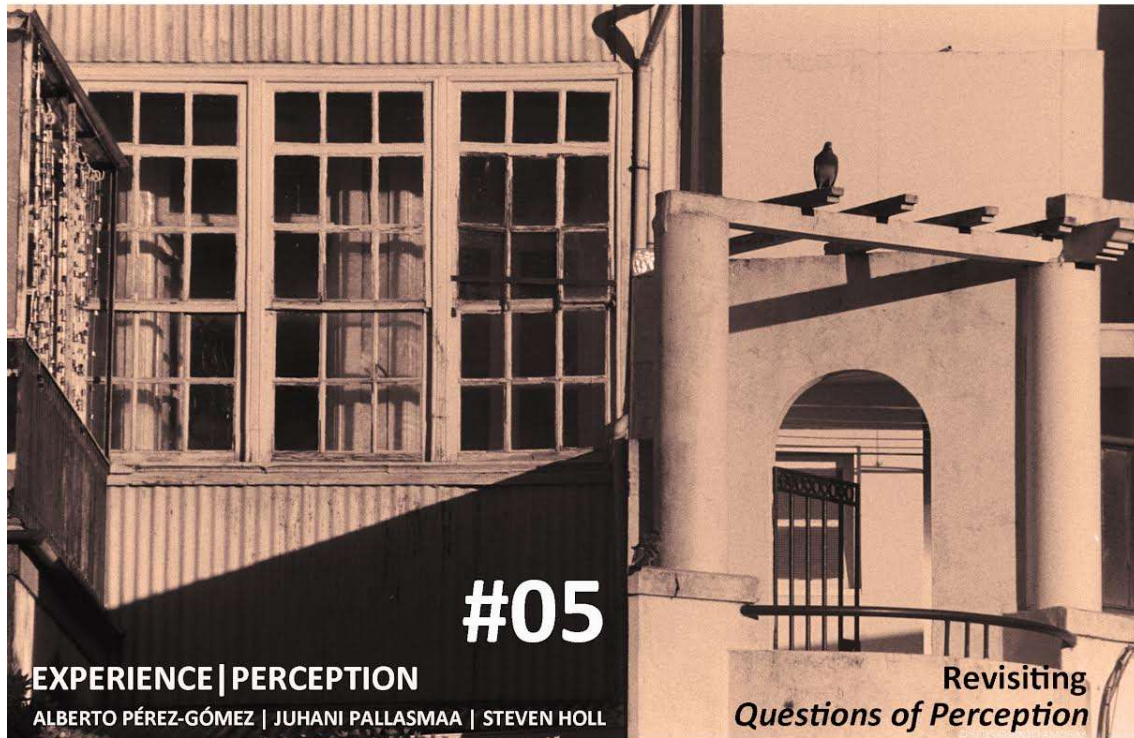

Lectures by Alberto Pérez-Gómez – *New questions around the primacy of perception in architecture*, Juhani Pallasmaa – *From Vision to Existential Sense: architecture and our experience of the world*; and Steven Holl – *Revisiting Questions of Perception*, on Monday, June 27th, summarize the research in their respective domains.

There will then be the opportunity to discuss the issues with the authors of *Questions of Perception* (1994/2007) and researchers from partner institutions in the thematic seminars #05_EXPERIENCE | PERCEPTION *Revisiting Questions of Perception*

In addition to the seminar, the exhibition *Timeless Aalto – The DNA of Building Culture* will open on Tuesday, the 28th, at the Fundação Instituto Arquitecto José Marques da Silva (FIMS Marques da Silva Foundation) of Universidade do Porto.

The exhibition on the timeless concepts of Alvar Aalto as a starting point was organized in Alvar Aalto's Säynätsalo Town Hall in the Summer of 2021. The exhibition material was partially displayed throughout the 2010s in Turku, Tampere, Helsinki and at Villa Lante in Rome. Conceptually, it is a dialogue between the History of Architecture and the life and work history of the Finnish architect Alvar Aalto. Prof. Emeritus Tore Tallqvist produced the exhibition in collaboration with the University of Tampere, the Alvar Aalto Museum, and the City of Jyväskylä OUR Urban Environment, and elaborated a specific leaflet for the exhibition at the University of Porto, Portugal.

Live sessions will be broadcast via streaming, recorded, and later edited and made available in open access on the digital platform ABLeS INTERSECTIONS.
